BEST PRACTICES

▲ [\[user-scalable="no"\]](#) is used in the `<meta name="viewport">` element or the [\[maximum-scale\]](#) attribute is less than 5.



These items highlight common accessibility best practices.

NAMES AND LABELS

▲ Links do not have a discernible name



These are opportunities to improve the semantics of the controls in your application. This may enhance the experience for users of assistive technology, like a screen reader.
